Welcome to Tyrol! Here you have an overview of where you can get information and where you can go if you have any questions.

Arrival in Tyrol:

- 1. Please go to the arrival center in Haus Marillac at Sennstraße 3, 6020 Innsbruck (open 24h).
- 2. Registration and a health check will be carried out there.
- 3. You will be assigned accommodation there. Transport will be organized for you.
- **4.** Please report to the arrival center and get a health check there, even if you already have an accommodation.

People who have fled Ukraine may use the entire public transportation network of Verkehrsverbund Tirol (VVT and IVB) without a ticket until March 31st, 2022. The trains of the Austrian Federal Railways (ÖBB) are also free of charge to refugees from Ukraine. This means you currently don't need to buy a ticket.
